This decision was made because some of the workers had to pull out because of their personal plans in travelling to their own families for the Christmas Season. Others gave up their personal plans in order that the clients would receive the Christmas Hampers.

Having spoken with Mick, the plan is now for BBC to do our own Hampers for Christmas. We would like to go through Social Services who could supply us with the names of local families who would desperately need the Hampers. This will, of course, have to be prayed over to see the plans God has for us and Social Services.
